- Always check Is it development and do I need permission complicated so don't take chances!
- Free advice from National Park Authority "Do I need permission"?
- Paid for advice on the development if permission is required good value. Most moorlands are in the "Natural Zone" so work must be essential for the management of the moor to comply with planning policy
- Check with other agencies e.g. Natural England don't assume that you can tell one of us and not the other
