Please find enclosed information regarding an invitation to tender for the Plug and Clump Planting Framework which includes 2 Mini-competitions.

This new framework agreement will run from September 2020 to September 2024 and will cover all aspects of planting plugs and clumps. **In order to tender for future plug and clump work for Moors for the Future Partnership you need to apply to be on the framework agreement.**

Once you have been accepted onto the framework agreement you will be invited to tender for works once a site and quantities have been identified. This will be a mini competition between the framework contractors only.

This invitation to tender also includes Lot 1 which is twelve packages of identified work on the sites of Turley Holes and Langfield, Rishworth, Moss Moor, Ashop, Close Moss, Soyland, Alport, Ronksley, Ilkley, Roaches, Bradfield and Cupwith. This invitation also includes Lot 2 which is one package of identified work on Dove Stone.
